- 1. Participated in the CSITC RT 2014-1 & 3 Round Trials
- 2. Performed tests of cotton samples as per requests from;

 - □ Olam Tanzania Ltd (660 samples)
 - ☐ Cotton Development Trust- Zambia (280 samples)
 - Wakefield Inspection Services Tanzania (70 samples)





STATUS OF THE CENTRE Cont......




- 3. Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS) supported the centre by paying maintenance and operational costs of the centre e.g AAMS service costs.
